SCHOLARSHIPS:

Mumbulla School for Rudolf Steiner Education Scholarship

- Established in 2017, the Mumbulla School for Rudolf Steiner Education Scholarship will be awarded to offer equitable access and is open to Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia for new student placement only.

One full scholarship will be available when donations have accrued to enable a student to complete their education from Kindergarten to Class 6 at Mumbulla School, that is seven years. This will be subject to annual review to ensure scholarship criteria continue to be met.

APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP:

- Applicants must apply using the Scholarship Form and pay a non-refundable application fee of \$20 (incl GST) when submitting their application.
- The scholarship application process is available to individuals in the Bega Valley, South Eastern NSW, Australia wide and/or overseas providing applicants are Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia.
- Scholarship application requires evidence of financial hardship. Such evidence can be provided through tax return information and/or a Centrelink Income Assessment (see Scholarship Application form).
- Families of applicants are required to be committed to the education principles of Mumbulla School for Rudolf Steiner education (see Scholarship Application form).
- Parents/Carers of applicants are required to demonstrate commitment to Mumbulla School through signing the Enrollment contract. (This Contract is available with the Scholarship Application form.)

DONATIONS:

Donations can be accepted at any time for the Mumbulla School for Rudolf Steiner Scholarship. However, we have applied in June 2017 and are awaiting Australian Tax Office approval for Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) status enabling tax deduction for any gift over \$2. Donations are deposited into a separate Scholarship bank account for scholarship award purposes only.

If DGR status is granted Mumbulla School will initiate fundraising and greater community awareness of the scholarship. This awareness will be further increased and the application process will be opened for application once adequate funds are available to ensure funding of at least one place for a child to attend Mumbulla School from Kindergarten to Class 6.
