The Role of the Music Teacher is to:

- Teach percussion skills (body percussion, tuned and untuned percussion such as marimbas and drums)
- Teach folk, world and traditional music
- Be familiar with the pentatonic scale for younger classes
- Develop a day to day and term plan of music lessons to show other teachers
- Provide clear directions and instructions when teaching, and present tasks suitable to child's age/ability.
- Teach basic theory

In relation to working in the school, you will be expected to:

- Attend meetings of the College of Teachers when required.
- Be available for playground and other duties.
- Attend and participate in relevant Curriculum/Staff Development days and in-service or training courses.
- Participate in the school's mentoring and evaluation program.
- Be available to attend relevant meetings and workshops outside school hours.
