In addition, the strings instructor will be required to work with an ensemble.

SELECTION CRITERIA Strings Specialist Instructor 2024

- Ability to play violin and viola, including a relevant degree or diploma in Music or Music Education.
- Demonstrated experience teaching one or more of these instruments to students, preferably in a school settling.
- Demonstrated ability to work with individual, small group and ensemble groups of students.
- Work as a team, liaising with the Music Teacher, other music tutors, teachers and staff.
- Assess and report on student progress in a timely manner.
- Demonstrated high level interpersonal and communication skills, including the ability to establish strong links with students, families, and the school community.
- A willingness to attend and participate in performing arts events, including out of hours, as required. Experience in the planning and delivery of concerts is an advantage.
- Willingness and ability to learn, to be flexible and to be reflective.
